BYLAW NO. 238

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH FEES AND CHARGES FOR USE OF THE
STRATHCONA GARDENS RECREATION FACILITY**

WHEREAS the Regional District may, by bylaw, establish fees and charges payable in respect of all or part of a service, or for the use of Regional District property and, for those purposes, establish different classes of persons, property, businesses and activities and set different rates for different classes;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District desires to establish fees and charges for use of the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex and the property upon which it is located;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Rates

1. The use of the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex by groups and individuals is subject to payment in advance of the fees, charges, rentals or other rates specified in Schedule A, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

L.I.F.E. Program

2. Despite Section 1, individuals and families who qualify for access to recreational facilities under the provisions of the L.I.F.E. Program may apply on the form prescribed in Schedule B, attached to and forming part of this bylaw, for free or subsidized rates available under that program.

Prior Rates

3. A fee or charge paid for an admission, use, occupancy, event or other service at the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex prior to the effective date of this bylaw shall be valid and sufficient notwithstanding that the admission, use, occupancy, event or other service for which it was paid does not occur until a later date.

Repeal

4. Bylaw No. 174, being Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex Fees and Charges Bylaw 2013 is repealed.

Effective Date

5. This bylaw becomes effective on January 1, 2016.

Citation

6. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 238, being Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex Fees and Charges Bylaw 2016.

SCHEDULE 'A'

Fees and Charges

PART A – GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. In this schedule the following definitions apply:

“admission” means to admit a person for the purpose of participation in an unorganized session of swimming or skating;

“adult” means a person who is at least 19 years of age;

“advertising” means communication in any medium intended to inform, influence, promote or induce persons to participate in an activity or consume a product;

“business” means a commercial entity which charges a fee to attend or participate in its events;

“caregiver” means an adult providing care and supervision to a pre-schooler;

“cheap leisure skate” means the discounted rate in effect when the leisure skating rink is the only ice skating rink available for use;

“cheap leisure swim” means the discounted rate in effect when the leisure pool is the only swimming pool available for use;

“child” means a youth between the ages of 3 and 12 years inclusive;

“cost recovery” means the recovery of costs without profit;

“external advertising” means advertising that is placed, attached or affixed to the interior of the Strathcona Gardens or to another structure located on the property upon which the Strathcona Gardens is located;

“facility” means the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex, or some part of it, and the land upon which it is situated;

“family” means a group of not more than 6 people containing one or two adults;

“internal advertising” means advertising that is placed, attached or affixed to the interior of the Strathcona Gardens or to any machinery, equipment or building component located inside the Strathcona Gardens;

“L.I.F.E. program” means the “Leisure Is For Everyone” program which provides free or subsidized access to recreation programs and events for low income families and individuals;

“non-profit organization” means a group which is not a business;

“pre-schooler” means a youth who is under the age of 3 years;

“prime time” means

- the period commencing June 1 and ending August 31; and
- the period commencing on September 1 and ending on May 31,
 - between 6:00 am and midnight on weekends and school holidays, and
 - between 3:00 p.m. and midnight, Monday through Friday;

“school holiday” means a day between September 1 and May 31, other than a day on a weekend, that schools are closed within School District No. 72;

“senior” means an adult who is at least 60 years of age;

“student” means a teenager who is currently enrolled in a course of studies at an educational institution;

“teen” means a youth between the ages of 13 and 18 years inclusive;

“user group” means a non-profit organization which has a current rental agreement for use of the facility;

“weekend” means the period commencing immediately after midnight on Friday and ending at midnight on the next Sunday;

“youth” means a person who is not an adult.

2. All fees, charges and other rates set out in this schedule are exclusive of taxes unless otherwise noted.
3. The Regional District may, in its sole discretion, enter into agreements for use of the facility that include rates different than the rates established in this bylaw.
4. Nothing in this schedule limits the authority of the Regional District to charge for costs incurred on behalf of or in connection with the provision of a program, activity, event or service to a user or group of users, including payments made to a third party for operating, facilitating, setting up, demobilizing or tearing down facilities, decorations, furnishings and other paraphernalia on a cost recovery basis.
